## TIMBER FOLDING DOORS TOE & HEEL DEVICE

## **UNGLAZED DOORS**

If the door panels have been supplied unglazed it is recommended that you glaze the panels prior to installation by supporting the panels on a bench and inserting the sealed units so that the weight of the glass helps provide a positive seal against the external glazing tape. Fit the glazing beads ensuring positive sealing against the internal surface of the glass and use the pins supplied to fix in position.

## Toe and Heel - Auto toe and heel device adjustment

- 1. In the top of each panel you will find a Pozi-Head screw bolt.
- 2. The doors panels will already be at their lowest point.
- 3. With the doors in the closed position, identify any panels that require lifting.
- 4. Open the doors so that you can get access to the auto toe and heel device at the top of the door panel
- 5. Wind the screw head clockwise, this will cause the corner of the door to rise.
- 6. Re-close the doors and check that they run parallel and evenly to the top and bottom tracks.
- 7. If they do not, then repeat as necessary.
